**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Swindon Borough Council proposes to make the above Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, The Traffic Management Act 2004 and The Transport Act 2000 and all other enabling powers and in consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police. The effect of the Order is to introduce a bus lane on the nearside lane of the eastbound carriageway on B4006 Pipers Way between the Nationwide Roundabout towards Pipers Roundabout.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

### **B4006 PIPERS WAY BUS LANE**

The introduction of the bus lane on B4006 Pipers Way will help maximise the journey reliability for the local bus network, particularly during peak times. As congestion is at its most severe during these peak hours, the time saving for buses and other approved vehicles aims to encourage road users to use these services.

To address the concerns raised Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO) and recommends 24 hour bus lane.

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For facilitating the passage on the road for any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- b. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area
- c. to assist with the free flow of traffic,

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
