I have attached a list of the litter bins in the Parish that I have received from StreetSmart. This does not include the bins within the parks, which come under the grounds maintenance team. I can also see that there are some not included that are in Broadgreen

Following the last newsletter, a number of requests from the public have been received for new bins. I have listed the locations.

Mill Lane (by the bridleway to East Wichel)  
 Marlborough Road (near underpass)  
 Whitbourne Ave (by bus stop adjacent shops)  
 Faringdon Road (entrance to park)  
 Marlborough Road (half way between Old Town and Broome Manor Lane)  
 Balmoral Close (Junction of Queens Drive)  
 Sandringham Road (near Marlborough Road junction)  
 Okus Road (bus stop outside No 100)  
 Replace existing bins in Westlecot Road (junction of Roman Crescent) and (junction The Mall)  
 Celsus Grove (near play area)  
 Roman crescent (near footpath )  
 Replace dog bin with litter bin at Commonweal School (exact location not given)

Would Councillors like to look at the locations in their ward and see whether they support.  
 Would Councillors also like to suggest other locations.

This will be on the agenda of the next P & E Committee Meeting to purchase new bins.

The attached bins have been selected by some Councillors and will need to be agreed at the meeting. The bins will then become the design used by the Parish Council for all future bins. These bins cost £431.95 each and that does not include fitting.
