We've sadly just had to announce that we're unable to run The Children's Fete this year. With the difficulties we've had trying to get The Baker's Cafe operating well, with Daniel moving to Greece and being as small a team as we are, we just haven't had the capacity or energy to fundraise for the event this year and we didn't want to rely on a big grant from the Parish again.

This isn't the end of The Children's Fete, we intend to start planning, fundraising and building a team of people now for the 2020 event.

For the moment though, we need to speak about the Trust repaying the portion of the grant from last year that we agreed on, or whether you would like us to use this for the 2020 event. We are happy with either scenario of course, but it would be great to be able to start the fundraising knowing we have £3000 from the Parish to get going with. I am in the process of setting up the separate bank for the event as I discussed with you when we received the grant.
