Dear Joyce

I have been provided with a copy of your e-mail below, with a request that I answer it directly.

The Council is looking to review and update its adopted Parking Standards. The first phase of the review has been an informal consultation process, including a Residents Questionnaire. The Questionnaire is intended to help us understand public opinion and reflect it, where possible, within a draft of a document that will be presented to Planning Committee early in the new year. Subject to the approval of the draft by Committee, a formal consultation will be undertaken, the results of which will be re-presented to Committee in the Spring. The Parish Council will be consulted formally at that time.

We are aware generally of the views of Members and their concern for the effects of inadequate provision of car parking. These concerns are being reflected within the emerging draft of the document.

I hope this gives you some comfort that we are still in the early stages of the standards review. The Parish Council will be consulted, once a draft of the new document has been completed and considered by Cabinet and by the Planning Committee.
