More specifically, I would like to see a tree planted on the grass verge at the bottom of Melbourne Close, ideally an Ash or Sycamore, and some more planted on/around the grass verge around the bend of Buckingham Road.

The woodland trust are crying out for people to take on tree planting, and with the help of the council, the majority of empty green spaces (or the ones which are not already subjected to planning applications) could REALLY benefit.
