For what purpose or project is the grant requested?	<p>The money requested would be used to cover the cost of hiring the Youth Room at Broadgreen Community Centre in order for BFM to run 2 free 12 week parenting programmes- Managing Challenging Behaviour Family Links Nurturing Programme</p> <p>Whilst BFM can cover the costs for trained facilitators to deliver the programmes there is no budget for the hire of a venue.</p> <p>Both parenting programmes allow parents to explore the impact of their parenting and relationships on their child's self-esteem and self-awareness, as well as learning techniques for positive discipline and having appropriate expectations.</p> <p>Data from previous groups has shown an 82% improvement in parenting ability of those who completed the programme.</p> <p>Both programmes are evidence based</p>

		<p>and help parents to develop a greater understanding of their own child's development and the causes of their child's behaviour. Parents will learn strategies that will help them as parents to manage the behaviours and build resilience in their children.</p> <p>As well as this the group settings allow the parents attending to develop friendships and establish their own support networks which in turn reduce their social isolation.</p>
8.	What will be the total cost of the above project?	<p>£14 per hour x 3.5 hours x 10 weeks (2 weeks of the course are home visits) =£490</p> <p>£490 x 2 courses = £980.00</p>
9.	If the total cost of the project is more than the grant, how will the residue be financed?	N/A
10.	<p>Have you applied for grant for the same project to another organisation?</p> <p>If so, which organisation and how much?</p>	No

Who will benefit from the project?	<p>Parents who are struggling to cope with their children's behaviour, waiting for their child to be diagnosed or who are just having difficulties parenting.</p> <p>In the longer term the benefit will be not only parents and their children but their wider families and the community as a whole.</p> <p>Effective parenting support provides significant positive outcomes for children and communities such as raising self-esteem and educational achievement. It can also reduce anti- social behaviour, the likelihood of older children developing psychological distress and the long term chance of substance abuse.</p> <p>Moreover there is proven to be a significant decrease of those families</p>

		having reduced or no contact with health and social services.
12.	Approximately how many of those who will benefit are parishioners?	The programmes would be open to parents living across Swindon including those in the South Swindon Parish area.
