Dear Parish Councillors, just to send you some good news for Swindon Central South parish and to thank the parish council for its support during the bid process....

'We are delighted to be able to announce that our bid for a Heritage Action Zone for Swindon has been approved and Historic England will be working with us over the next five years to deliver vital enhancements to the area around the Railway Village and Railway Works. A press release will be published in the local media later today. Thank you for your support for our bid which was much appreciated and undoubtedly added weight to our submission.'

The official start date for the HAZ will be April 2019. In the intervening period we will be preparing a detailed delivery plan based on the draft list of potential projects to be progressed by the HAZ.
