Following my proposal to the South Central Parish Council on 11th of December 2018 in regards to the construction of a Sculpture for the remembrance of international mother language day at the GWR park, which the proposal was overwhelmingly supported by the Amenities and Leisure committee and ratified by the full Parish council, However as the Borough Council is still the landlord of the park an application had to be made for the boroughs approval.

I am writing to update you that the borough have now given their consent for the construction of the Sculpture and the Bangladesh Association is now in a position to order the sculpture for it to be constructed at the Park. I have also been advised by the planing department that planing consent is not required as this falls within permitted development.

Please note that the construction work will be starting in the next 4/5 weeks and at the cost of £12-£14,000.
