

## Youth Worker Working Party

### General

The Youth Worker Working Party will report to the Finance & Staffing Committee.

The Youth Worker Working Party will consider all aspects of the appointment of Youth Workers and make recommendations to the Finance & Staffing Committee on the specifics of the role to be created.

The Youth Worker Working Party will be made up of Councillors

### Terms of Reference

1. To consider the role required for youth work in South Swindon and make recommendations to the Finance & Staffing Committee.
2. To consider the locations for the provision of the youth service including the use of key central hubs such as Broadgreen Community Centre, Eastcott Community Centre, Park Community Centre and the Lawn Community Centre. East Wichel may also be a future provision centre for consideration.
3. To monitor the progress and success of the various areas of youth provision highlighting those areas that work well and those that are less successful, recommending further resource allocation if required.
4. To evaluate and consider whether the provision is an inhouse service or a joint venture in partnership with another parish that already has a successful scheme in place.
5. To consider how best to engage with local religious groups to establish an open for all programme of events.
6. To make recommendations on the running of the youth provision within the parish.
7. To advise of any other issues relating to the provision of Youth Services within the parish.
8. Consider future options for Youth Worker to include direct employment of staff.
9. To highlight changes to budget requirements as the service develops.
