Structures made of large stones, utilizing an interlocking system without the use of mortar or cement. Standing stones, orthostats, or more commonly known as megaliths because of their large and cumbersome size are solitary stones set vertically in the ground and come in many different varieties.

Where they appear in groups together, often in a circular formation, they are sometimes called megalithic monuments. Standing stones are found throughout the world with no known or documented history.
