Please be advised that I have a request for naming the units for the development formerly known as Great Western One.

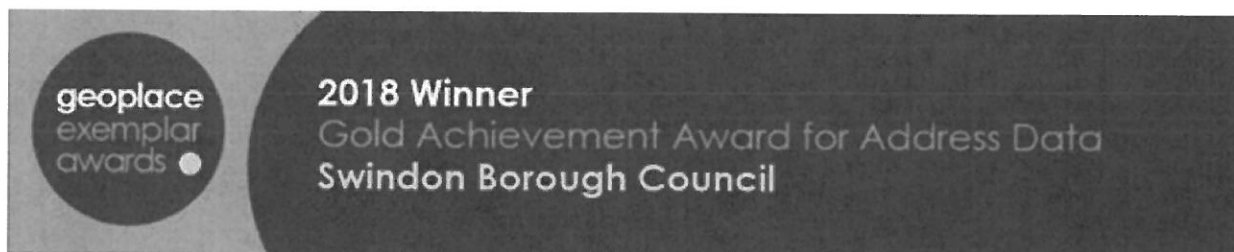
