

Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2017 (Variation No 4) Order 2019

STATEMENT OF REASONS

As part of the Kimmerfields Development in Swindon Town Centre, the Council need to extinguish the highway rights on Carfax Street, Turl Street, Carfax Close and Merton Crescent. In conjunction with the Stopping Up of Highway process, any traffic regulation orders, for parking or traffic movements, applicable to these streets need to be revoked.

The reason for making this order is for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
