Hi Joyce

Thanks for forwarding your correspondence with Rob.

I have just spoken to Linda Kasmaty, secretary of the Old Town Residents' Association which has taken over management of several of the Old Town flowerbeds (Mr Cod, corner of Newport St/Devizes Road, Station Approach underneath the billboard, the beds alongside the Co-op in Newport St and the bed at the end of the railway embankment facing onto the Marriott roundabout). OTRA have commissioned a local metalworker to produce some small metal plaques to install in the beds so people will know who is looking after them.

Linda and I were both under the impression that the parish had agreed that OTRA should also be in charge of the Museum beds and that there is no need for Streetsmart to be involved in their maintenance. It doesn't work for both parties to be involved, because Streetsmart plants annuals and OTRA have planted perennials and have more to put in. Linda tells me that OTRA volunteers have put in some work on the Museum beds this past weekend.

Can I suggest that Streetsmart cancel the proposed summer planting and that the museum beds are added to the agenda for next Tuesday's Leisure and Amenities committee meeting?
