The Parish Council is changing the way that grants will be considered in the future.

Applications will need to be made by the end of October 2018 and will then be paid out the following May.

This will mean that all grants will be considered at the same time and there will be a fair distribution of the funds available.

Living Wage Employer

South Swindon Parish Council is pleased to announce that they have been accredited as a Living Wage Employer by the Living Wage Foundation.

Their Living Wage commitment will see everyone working, regardless of whether they are direct employees or third-party contracted staff receives a minimum hourly wage of £8.75 in the UK or £10.20 in London. Both rates are significantly higher than the statutory minimum for over 25s.

The real Living Wage is an hourly rate set independently and updated annually and is calculated according to the real costs of living.

South Swindon Parish Council is one of only 11 Parish Councils in the country that have received this accreditation and the first in Wiltshire.

Cllr Chris Watts, Chair of South Swindon Parish Council said 'I am very pleased that the Parish Council has received this accreditation. It shows that the Parish Council are a responsible employer and that it is important to them to look after staff and ensure that a fair wage is paid.'

Broadgreen Street Food Festival

StreetSmart Contract

The Parish Council has arranged for a Best Value Review to be made of the current services being provided by StreetSmart.

The report has been considered by the Parish Council and the decision taken to continue with StreetSmart for the coming year.

Councillors will be working through the detail of the document in the coming months to work towards being able to enter a longer-term contract for the future.

World War 1 Commemoration

The Parish Council has commissioned a new memorial to commemorate the centenary of World War 1. The memorial will be erected in GWR Park adjacent to the Army Reserve Centre.

The memorial has been designed by local Swindon artist Dr Mike Pringle and should be completed before November 2018.

There will also be new seating at the memorial and it is planned to be an area of quiet contemplation.

The Parish Council has plans for other events taking place in November which will include a photo trail in Queens Park and poppy rocks in Town Gardens.
