Important Information - Waste Disposal in Broadgreen

High volumes of large household items such as sofas, fridges, freezers, furniture and mattresses are being dumped in the Broadgreen area. Dumping of these items is illegal and will attract a fine of £400.

To avoid this illegal activity and a fine you can either take these items to the Household Waste Recycling Centre at Darby Close free of charge or Swindon Borough Council also provides a **Bulky Waste** collection at a small cost; further information on this service can be found at www.swindon.gov.uk and on the information sheet enclosed with this letter.

You can also arrange for the waste to be collected privately through a registered trade waste carrier. You must check that a waste carrier is licenced otherwise you remain responsible for the waste and this can be confirmed online at the following government website using either the licence number or name of the business - www.environment.data.gov.uk/public-register/view/search-waste-carriers-brokers. *If a waste carrier is not licenced you must not use them.*

Please also be aware that general household waste is being dumped illegally and this creates a very poor environment for residents to live in. Most of the waste that you produce is recyclable which is good for the environment and also allows you to dispose of your household waste legally. Household waste and recycling is collected on your regular waste collection so please make use of this service.
