281 Transport Requirements for Development Presentation – 26 October 2017

The Clerk submitted for information an email dated 30 October 2017 from the Senior TDM Engineer at Swindon Borough Council a copy of which appears as Appendix F in the Minute Book.

Cllr Burns-Howell and Firmin reported on a meeting they had attended on 26 October 2017 regarding the transport requirements for new developments.

Cllr Burns-Howell reported that the document was available to view on-line and that Swindon Borough Council would no longer be producing a paper copy of the document. It was a substantial document and the on-line version would make it easier to update sections, without the need for re-printing the whole document. Cllr Firmin reported that there was nothing controversial in the document and requests had been made to provide for electric cars. Cllr Burns-Howell added that he was pleased to see provision for cycling.

Swindon Borough Council would also be securing higher contributions from developers in the future to cover the long-term maintenance of facilities.
