Public Session	<p>A member of the public asked for an update on retrospective planning for 79 Gladstone Street takeaway food outlet. The Deputy Clerk responded that there had been no update from Swindon Borough Council.</p> <p>A member of the public said that 20 Manchester Road seemed to have been let or sublet and the interior downstairs had been converted to a ladies hair salon without planning or change of use permission. the Deputy Clerk & Cllr P Herring said that the Parish Council will check the detail and follow up with Swindon Borough Council.</p> <p>A member of the public referred to a previous planning meeting when Cllr N Hopkins had asked if Swindon Borough Council would attend a meeting with the Parish Council to explain their processes as decisions, they are making appear to conflict with the parish responses. The Deputy Clerk said that the borough council have said that they do not turn down applications based on objections the parish have made. The Deputy Clerk advised that he would collate a number of case studies and request a meeting with the borough council.</p> <p>Cllr C Watts said that most of the parish comments are based on the borough councils' own approved standards and although the parish have requested meetings with them, they had not yet agreed.</p> <p>A member of the public had attended a meeting regarding Newburn Sidings and said that SHELAA had been denied and could not see how the crossroads at Red Post Drive would work. Cllr C Watts said that the Traffic Management had not been finalised and the Highways Department will have an opinion as a statutory consultee. Cllr P Herring said that the parish will wait until the full plans are received before further comment.</p> <p>A member of the public said that a planning application had been made by a neighbour. He had objected to the application and confirmed that the parish had also made an objection, the member of the public is unhappy with the process and wanted to know if he will be informed of any revised application made. The Deputy Clerk said that the borough council would advise him if a revised application is made and if a revised application is received by the parish, the parish will inform the member of the public via email.</p>
